## JUDGES

**Susan Fornaro** has exhibited her art across New England, and is an award-winning member of Weston Arts and Crafts Association, Danforth Museum of Art and Beacon Hill Art Walk. Her work has been shown the Blanche Ames National Juried Art Exhibition in Easton, and in 2007, she took part in the New England Representational Painting Exhibit at the Guild of Boston Artists.

Her commissioned works include a tromp l'oeil mural at Harvard Dental School, a mural and 32 children's paintings for Children's Hospital in Boston, five paintings for Pilgrim/CVS Health Life Center in New Bedford, 23 pieces of children's art for Bay State Medical Center in Springfield, and many house portraits.

She earned an MA in Expressive Arts Therapy from Lesley University, a BA in Psychology from Central Connecticut State University, and studied at the Cape Cod School of Art and Rhode Island School of Design.

Her work is seasonally exhibited at Gallery 333 in North Falmouth and Zullo Gallery in Medfield. She is the year-round featured artist at Jimmy's Café in Wellesley.

**Sheila Oliveira** is a professional photographer and graphic designer working for art galleries and local publications. She teaches courses in film and digital photography at the University of Massachusetts Dartmouth, where she earned both a BFA in Visual Design/Photography and an MFA in Visual Design/Studio Photography.

She believes in bringing art and art education to the community. She is curator and gallery director for the Greater Fall River Art Association and serves as chairman of the Rehoboth Cultural Council (an agency of the Massachusetts Cultural Council), a grassroots cultural funding network that supports community-based projects in the arts, humanities and sciences.

Her work is included in the corporate collections of St. Anne's Hospital and Heritage State Park, both located in Fall River, as well as in numerous private collections.

**Kim Weineck**, wife, mother, artist and teacher, always seeks time to paint in her combination studio/children's playroom. She works in all mediums, but favors oils and pastels, switching between them as the subject dictates.

This year Kim was juried into two prestigious pastel societies: as a signature member of the Pastel Painters Society of Cape Cod and the Pastel Society of America. She is founder of and an instructor at Neponset Valley Artists, and an artist member of the Arts Foundation of Cape Cod, Foxboro Art Association and Marion Art Center.

Her work is shown at Gallery9 in Norwood, where it will be featured in October; the Art Gallery at Patriot Place; Preservation Framers; and Nest; among others. It has been featured in *Yankee* and is held in many collections in the United States and abroad.

Kim graduated with distinction from MassArt with special study at the Pont-Aven School of Contemporary Art in France.
