# November's Demo



We were fortunate to host another pleasant demonstration by popular and bubbly pastel artist Kim Weineck on November 16, 2016.

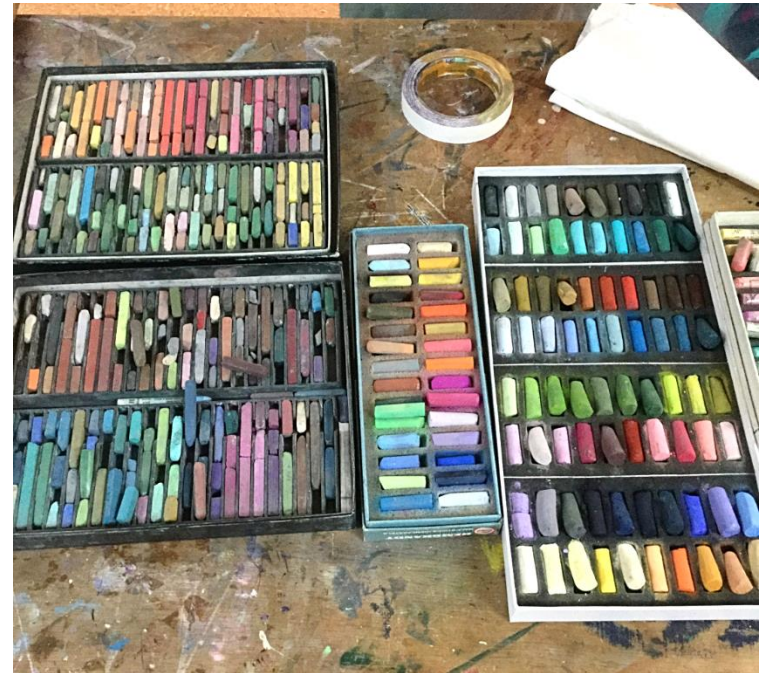
In anticipation of the holiday season Kim decided to do a window decorated on the outside with a wreath and on the inside with a Christmas cactus and candles. The board used was a gray pastelbord by Ampersand.

Kim has a variety of pastels but loves the Sennelier plein air pastel set. She recommends using the ValueViewer app. In addition to showing gray values, it grids and does proportions. She noted that a color can't be wrong if the value is correct.

Kim won't start a project unless it has a "light story". This

painting she did certainly did have a light story. Kim started the process by doing all the areas where the colors needed to be kept clean and not muddied with other colors. The lightest lights and darkest darks were applied, then she worked her way around the painting here and there with sure strokes. Kim blended by layering colors. Layering does not flatten the colors out like blending with your fingers.
