November Demo

Sarah started by showing us her materials. She worked on Uart paper and used several sets of pastels - Dakota, Blue Earth, Girault, Terry Ludwig and Sennelier.

She pre-sketched the scene in pencil, then began by filling in areas, working more on values than detail. Once she has it all colored in she brings out the alcohol and begins painting with watercolor brushes, allowing the alcohol to affect her colors and shapes. The alcohol makes the colors sink into the paper, disbursing the color and eliminating the white. This is the underpainting.

After allowing the alcohol to dry thoroughly, Sarah finished her work by defining the details of the scene and enhancing the colors with highlights and shadows.
