Sally Caswell is an award-winning, internationally exhibiting artist whose watercolors and oil paintings, resonant with color, reveal her keen sense of observation, evoke a mood and a sense of place. Sally is listed in *Who's Who in American Art*. She is a Copley Artist of the Copley Society of Art, Boston, MA, a Signature Artist and Life Member of The Rhode Island Watercolor Society, a juried artist member of 19 on Paper and formerly of Providence Art Club. She was selected as an Artist Member of the Copley Society of Boston in 1993, and was awarded the distinction of Copley Artist in January of 1998.

"Working *en plein air* to create fresh, vibrant, colorful images that capture the essence of the landscapes and seascapes or painting a variety of subjects from portraits and landscapes to still lives and abstractions, I enjoy working from life. Most of my works are created on location or developed in my studio from on location sketches, oil paintings or watercolors".
