October Demo



Our October demonstrator was watercolor artist Richard Marthers.

His demo was very enjoyable and informative, sprinkled with good humor.

Richard handed out copies of the palette he uses, and then created a value painting to show the use of shape, lights, and darks. He explained how he decides what a painting will be like before he begins working on it.

Richard uses American Journey watercolor paints, and his favorite brush is a one-inch Hake brush. His planning process is to find a good photograph as a reference and then use everything he can to bring it to life. Richard stresses the importance of a sketchbook. Shapes, values, and the use of warm and cool colors are also very important in his work.

One of Richard's favorite studio tools is a lightbox, which he uses to transfer his sketch to Arches 140 pound paper. For his larger works, he will also use Arches 300 pound paper.
