

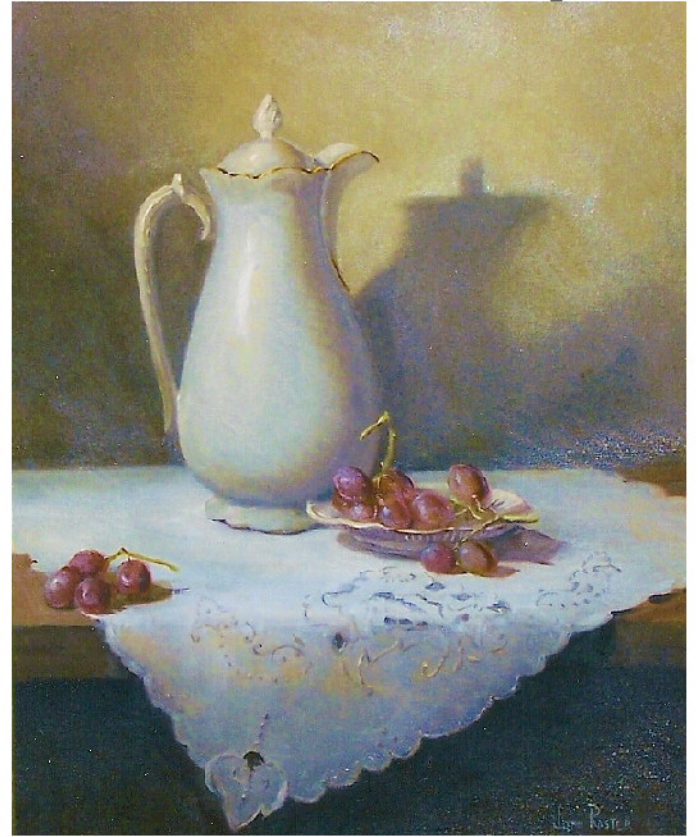

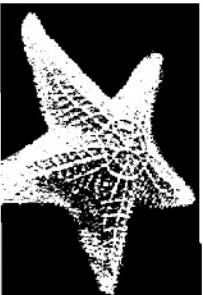

We start our homage to our past presidents with Joan Roster, one of the founders of TAA. Joan served several times as president from 1975-1976, 1978-1980 and 1996-1998. When TAA was first formed meetings were held in her home then at TMLP. When TAA found a home at our current location, her husband Ed, an attorney, set up all the legal work gratis and wrote the initial lease.

Joan first started oil painting with Rega Martin in Norton. She was then so taken with Ed Harrington's work that she studied under him for 20 years and learned a lot about land/seascapes. She has also studied under Marshall Joyce and Helen Van Wyk.

While studying under Helen, Joan was invited to exhibit in 5 galleries in MA & R.I. and sold many paintings and started teaching in her studio.

Joan had also studied at RISD, Museum of Fine Arts and Wheaton College. After seeing Ron Brake's watercolors she thought it would be fun to try a different medium and studied under Ron for 3-4 years.

Now retired from painting, Joan still tries to stay involved with TAA and is always supportive of our endeavors.
