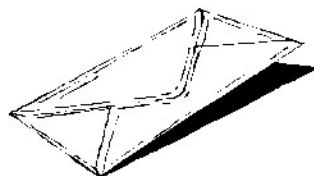

On Wednesday, February 20 at 7:00 pm, TAA will welcome Shelly Eager as our guest pastel demonstrator.

Shelly comes to painting through her background as an interior designer and world traveler. She learned the importance of balance, scale, color and composition through her design work. The art, patterns, history and colors of the many cultures she visited has taught her to see through many eyes.

In the fall of 2000 Shelly began to paint. She learned her technique by studying books and the works of masters. Recently she has studied with Albert Handell, Frank Federico, Rosalie Nadeau and Robert Carsten.

Shelly participated in an artist in residence program in Latvia in 2003. She spent 3 weeks living and painting amongst the people of a medieval village along with 13 international artists. Her work is now part of the permanent collection of the Museum Istade Nams in Cesis, Latvia.

Shelly belongs to many art groups including the Copley Society of Art and the Attleboro Arts Museum. Her works hang in museums in the U.S. and Europe. She has had pieces in the Texas Instrument Corporate Collection as well as the EMC collection.
