



Arthur began painting in 1945 while attending high school. Upon his retirement in 1978, he studied with Middleboro artists Leland Smith and Rober Schofield. Since then Arthur has studied with many artists including Roger Curtis, Robert Cormier, Edward Harrigan and Marshall Joyce.

Arthur has been a member of various art associations including the Bierstadt Art Society of New Bedford and the Old Lyme Art Association of Connecticut. He is a past president of the Taunton and Middleboro Art Associations and was a winner of the Grumbacher Silver Medal Award.

For the past 23 years Arthur has been the art instructor for oil painting at the Middleboro Council on Aging. He enjoys seascapes which were influenced by his childhood in Ocean Grove and his time in the Navy. Currently he enjoys landscape painting "plein air".

Since September means back-to-school, check out www.stubbypencilstudio.com. This website has a variety of eco-friendly products for children. Crayons are made from soy, not petroleum and pencils are made from sustainably harvested wood, not dying forests. They have a line of greeting cards called Color 'n Kids, which are made from 100% post consumer waste stock and have black and white illustrations for children to color and personalize. They come with biodegradable cello bags.

Amongst the many other products is a glue called EcoGlue. This glue is water resistant, non-toxic, and has less than 1% VOC's. It bonds paper, fabric, wood, stone, metal, ceramics, and more.
