

Judy, a lifelong resident of Middleboro, member of TAA and Tresurer since 2009, has been sewing since childhood. From doll clothes to her own wardrobe, she was taught by her mother and Judy's family boasts a number of quilters.

In 1976 Judy was given a double bed quilt top with the Wedding Ring pattern that was constructed by her grandmother but never completed. This was the first quilt Judy ever worked on and the rest is history. She has been making quilts and quilted items ever since and at Christmas she'll do multiple projects for family members

Judy states, "Today, there is no end to what can be accomplished! I love the fabrics that are available. Some are what I call 'yummy'. There are certain colors that are hard to leave on the shelf! It is fascinating to watch the designs come to life as the pieces are sewn together. It is definitely an art form. I am happiest when my hands are busy, so this additation to quilting suits me."
